

# Activating Windows

In 2026, Windows activation Toll Free : +1 (844) 886-3118 <https://mssupport.tech/> primarily relies on digital licenses or 25-character product keys. While official methods often require a purchase, there are several ways to activate Windows for free or reactivate it using existing entitlements.

## Checking Activation Status Toll Free : +1 (844) 886-3118 <https://mssupport.tech/>

Before attempting activation, confirm your current status:

- **Windows 11:** Go to **Start > Settings > System > Activation.**
- **Windows 10:** Go to **Start > Settings > Update & Security > Activation.**
- **Command Prompt (All versions):** Run the command `slmgr /xpr` to see if the machine is permanently activated.

## Free & Official Activation Methods Toll Free : +1 (844) 886-3118 <https://mssupport.tech/>

1. **Digital License Linking:** If you have previously activated Windows on your hardware, it is often linked to your Microsoft account. Signing in with that account on a new installation frequently activates the OS automatically.
2. **Windows 7/8/10 Key Reuse:** You can still use a valid product key from an older genuine version of Windows (7, 8, or 10) to activate a new installation of Windows 10 or 11, provided the edition (Home/Pro) matches.
3. **Hardware Change Troubleshooter:** If you replaced a major component like a motherboard, use the Toll Free : +1 (844) 886-3118 <https://mssupport.tech/> Select "I changed hardware on this device recently" to transfer your digital license.
4. **Windows Insider Program:** Joining the Windows Insider Program allows you to use pre-release builds of Windows 11 for free, though these versions may be less stable and include data collection.

## Script-Based Activation (Community Methods)

Open-source tools are widely used in 2026 for educational or testing purposes.

- **Microsoft Activation Scripts (MAS):** A highly regarded open-source tool available on Toll Free : +1 (844) 886-3118 {<https://mssupport.tech/>} It uses Hardware ID (HWID) activation to permanently link a license to your device.
- **KMS Command Line:** Users sometimes use the Command Prompt (Admin) to connect to Key Management Service (KMS) servers using commands like `s1mgr /ipk`, `s1mgr /skms`, and `s1mgr /ato`.
