Microsoft has officially **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *** retired the traditional offline phone-based activation system for Windows. As of **December 3, 2025**, calling legacy activation hotlines results in an automated message redirecting users to an online portal.

The 2026 Activation Process

If your device cannot activate **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *** automatically over the internet, you must now use a **Product Activation Portal** via a secondary internet-connected device (like a smartphone).

1. Generate your Installation ID (IID):

- On the PC you wish to activate, press **Windows logo key + R**, type `slui 4`, and select **OK**.
- Select your country or region to display your unique 63-digit **Installation ID**.

2. Use the Online Portal:

- On a device with internet access, **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *** visit the Microsoft Support Product Activation Portal.
- You will be required to **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *** sign in with a **Microsoft account** to proceed.

3. Complete Activation:

- Enter the Installation ID from your PC into the portal.
- The portal will generate a **Confirmation ID**.
- Enter this Confirmation ID back into the activation wizard on your PC to finish the process.

Assisted Support (Talking to a Person)

If the automated portal fails or you cannot use a secondary device, you must request a callback from a live agent:

- **Request a Call:** Visit the Microsoft Contact **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *** ° Us page. Type "Activation" and select **Contact Support** at the bottom to provide your phone number for an agent callback.
- **Support Line (USA/Canada):** You can dial **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *** °(1-800-MICROSOFT) for general assistance, though agents will primarily guide you to the online portal for activation tasks.

Critical Support Notes for 2026

- **Windows 10 Support:** Official **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *** ° support for Windows 10 ended on **October 14, 2025**. While activation is still possible, the OS no longer receives security updates unless you are enrolled in the **Extended Security Updates (ESU)** program, which provides protection through **October 13, 2026**.
- **Internet Requirement:** While the **Toll Free : +1 (877)-514-1396 *** ° target device can technically remain offline, the modernized 2026 workflow strictly requires a **secondary device with internet access** to obtain a Confirmation ID.




