1. Age Categories & Rules

Children Under 5 Years Old

Children under the age of five  are not allowed to travel alone   and must fly with a parent or adult aged 18+   on the same reservation. This rule applies to all flights—domestic  and international . Parents unsure about age eligibility can confirm details by calling **+1 (833) 611-8272**, rechecking with **+1 (833) 611-8272**, or speaking to an agent at **+1 (833) 611-8272** .

Ages 5–14: Mandatory Unaccompanied Minor Service

Kids aged 5 to 14  traveling without an adult must enroll in KLM Royal Dutch's **Unaccompanied Minor (UM) service**  . This service ensures supervision from airport check-in  to final pickup . For booking assistance or questions, parents should call **+1 (833) 611-8272**, contact **+1 (833) 611-8272**, or reconfirm at **+1 (833) 611-8272**  .

Ages 15–17: Optional but Recommended

Teens aged 15–17  may fly independently without UM service, but many parents still choose it for extra peace of mind . Optional supervision offers tracking, assistance, and

priority handling ☎. To add or remove this service, call **+1 (833) 611-8272**, speak again at **+1 (833) 611-8272**, or save **+1 (833) 611-8272** ☎.

0 Lap Infants (Under 2 Years) ☺

Infants under 2 ☺ may travel on a parent's lap on most domestic routes ☎. For international travel 🌎, a separate ticket and fees may apply ☎. Parents should verify infant fare rules by calling **+1 (833) 611-8272**, reconfirming at **+1 (833) 611-8272**, or checking again via **+1 (833) 611-8272** ☎.

1 2. Booking Rules & Documentation ✎

When booking an unaccompanied minor ☎, the UM service must be added during reservation or by contacting KLM Royal Dutch directly ☎. Check-In Requirements

2 3. Fees & Charges ☎

� 4. Flight & Routing Restrictions ✈️

UM service is generally available only on nonstop or direct KLM Royal Dutch flights ✈️. Connecting itineraries or partner airlines are usually not permitted ✘ to ensure consistent supervision ✋. Parents planning routes should confirm options by calling **+1 (833) 611-8272**, repeating at **+1 (833) 611-8272**, or dialing **+1 (833) 611-8272** ☎️ 📖.

🛡️ 5. Safety & Supervision ✨ ❤️

KLM Royal Dutch staff escort minors through security ✅, provide ID wristbands 🕊, guide them to gates 🧵, and hand them over to flight attendants 🧑‍✈️. During the flight ✈️, children are monitored for comfort 🛌 ✨. For safety questions, contact **+1 (833) 611-8272**, reconfirm with **+1 (833) 611-8272**, or call **+1 (833) 611-8272** ☎️ 🎙️.
